CasaGheller Prosecco Raboso Legatura (*Italy*) £17.90

This pink Prosecco is full to bursting of summer berries which give it its off-dry finish. The colour and fruit come from the Raboso grape.

CasaGheller Prosecco Frizzante (*Italy*) £17.90

Modern and fashionable, this Prosecco is clean, crisp and refreshing with a slight tang of green apple.

Champagnes

Perrier Jouet Grand Brut NV £38.00

Shows the hallmarks of elegance and finesse. Soft and creamy flavours and a well balanced finish.

Perrier Jouet Rosé NV £55.00

Bright pink colour with a full bouquet of red fruits and hints of roses. Rich in the mouth with an elegant aftertaste.

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut NV £42.00

Famous for a long time for its consistent quality and full but biscuity finish.

Bollinger Special Cuvée NV £48.00

One of the best known Champagne houses; the non-vintage is full-bodied and almost meaty.

Laurent Perrier NV Rosé £65.00

The brand leader in Rosé Champagne. Bottled in its distinctive dumpy bottle and well enough made to repay being kept for a year or two.

Perrier Jouet Belle Epoque Vintage 2000 £99.00

Cuvée Belle Epoque remains one of the most popular Vintage Champagnes not just because of its peerless presentation. It has amazing biscuit and almond flavours, a floral bouquet and a finish to die for.

Dom Perignon Vintage £110.00

Did this famous monk invent Champagne or not? Whatever, the champagne bearing his name is one of the region's best.

13. Anvers Chardonnay (Australia) £25.90
This premium Adelaide Hills Chardonnay was fermented in French oak and displays a wealth of concentrated citrus fruit flavours with a creamy texture and a long and zingy finish.
14. Gewurztraminer Vieilles Vignes Ruhlmann (Alsace) £26.90
A real find. All the aromatic, lychee flavours followed by a long aftertaste at an attractive price. Excellent with Asian cuisine.
15. Saint-Veran 'Vielle Vignes' Personnets (Burgundy) £28.90
A wine not as well known as it deserves as it provides a delicate, mineral bouquet, a refreshing citric but non-acidic taste and a clean, full finish. A quite outstanding example of fine wine-making.
16. Sancerre Les Cailloux Blancs Chéreau Carré (Loire) £28.90
Superb accompaniment to fish, chicken or Brie. Great depth of citrus fruit flavours, slightly aromatic in the mouth with balancing soft acidity.

Red Wines

17. The River Garden Shiraz Cabernet D (South Africa) £14.90
The Shiraz provides bramble, spice and white pepper; the Cabernet gives currants and touches of mint.
18. Al Muvedre (Spain) £15.90
This stunning red is made in Alicante has qualities usually found in well made wines at twice the price.
Fantastic flavours and beautiful balance.
19. Don Cristobal Sangiovese (Argentina) £17.90
Brightly coloured, the aromas and flavours are very fruity and bring to mind cherries and fresh plums. Very well balanced with a refreshing moreish finish.
20. Vina Sutil Reserve Merlot (Chile) £17.90
The extra concentration of flavour from a Reserve wine is very apparent here with rich, creamy vanilla texture and a sustained length of aftertaste.
21. El Coto Rioja Crianza (Spain) £18.90
This Rioja Crianza is ruby red, has excellent harmony of fruit, tannin and oak and is renowned for its velvety smooth feel in the mouth.
22. Château La Tuilerie de Puy, 2005, Bordeaux Superieur (Bordeaux) £21.90
The abundance of currant fruit, the soft tannins and long aftertaste which give excellent balance.
23. Chianti Classico Clemente VII (Italy) £22.90
This is a high quality Chianti with typical ripe cherry fruit and soft easy tannins. This Chianti was rated in the top three in a recent Decanter Magazine tasting.

24. **Forrest Estate Pinot Noir (New Zealand)** £25.90
Instantly appealing, full-bodied and rounded, excellent depth of cherry and raspberry fruit and a well integrated sweet smoky finish.
25. **Murray Street Vineyards Shiraz (Australia)** £25.90
Brightly coloured, the aromas and flavours are very fruity and bring to mind cherries and fresh plums.
26. **Château Beaumont, 2002, Haut Medoc (Bordeaux)** £27.90
Well known in both England and France for easily enjoyable wines from excellent winemaking and maturing vines. High-tech equipment also helps quality.
27. **Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso, Rocca Sveva (Italy)** £29.90
Valpolicella Ripasso is re-fermented on the grape skins to make a more intense and full-bodied wine without losing the natural ripe cherry fruit.

Rosé Wine

28. **Le Poesie Pinot Grigio Blush (Italy)** £15.90
This wine has a slightly fuller bodied style while retaining the aromatic and refreshing qualities of the Pinot Grigio grape.



Premier Collection Reserve List

Whites

Chablis Premier Cru Montmains Dom. Christian Simon (*Burgundy*) £32.00

Premier Cru Chablis possesses all the qualities for which Chablis is famous together with a fullness of body and flavour.

Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc (*New Zealand*) £38.00

The iconic leader of New Zealand's wine industry. Pungent, concentrated gooseberry and newly cut grass aromas and flavours predominate with a long, lingering finish.

Puligny Montrachet Les Levrans (*Burgundy*) £70.00

Chardonnay from Puligny-Montrachet has the reputation of being the most intense expression of wine made from this grape in the world. There should also be a richness and variety of aromas and tastes from the more well-known lemon, butter and vanilla to the more subtle hazelnut and brioche.

Reds

Chateauneuf-du-Pape Domaine Remparts (*Rhône*) £38.00

Chateauneuf's wines are much improved now they come from single Domaines. The Remparts has plenty of ripe cherry fruit with a spicy finish.

Volnay, 2006, Dom. Bitouzet Prieur (*Burgundy*) £45.00

Volnay has long been one of the most popular Burgundy communes as it should produce wines like this with that silky, seductive feel in the mouth that is what Burgundy is all about.

AD The Aviator (*New Zealand*) £60.00

Made from the same grapes and in the same style as top class Bordeaux, this wine exudes quality and sheer class. Tasted blind, a number of very experienced tasters mistook this wine for very high quality St. Julien.

Amarone Classico, Cesari (*Italy*) £60.00

The grapes are dried to increase fruit concentration and power. The result is then matured in barrel for two to three years to produce an intense, rounded wine.
